GASPARILLA GOLD chased saving ground, closed gap into lane, evenly late. SIMPLY THE TRUTH outrun to turn, three wide upper stretch, closed well late. WORKIN FOR SUCCESS attended pace three wide, loomed along turn, weakened. ROBYNS BROOK chased two wide along turn, no menacing response, tired. GIRL WITH A PEARL vied between rivals two wide, gave way along turn, empty.
