OFFLEE WILD stalked the early leaders from the two path, moved out to be three wide midway along the far turn, battled outside those rivals through the final furlong and prevailed under strong urging. FUNNY CIDE prompted the pace two wide, battled heads apart and between rivals through the lane and gamely just missed. THE LADY'S GROOM assumed the early lead, was rated along while on the rail, continued determinedly through the final furlong but was outfinished late. GYGISTAR stalked from the inside, was bottled up on the rail while inside rivals heading into far the turn, swung out four wide into upper stretch but could not continue with a late bid. EVENING ATTIRE, raced in contention from the outside, was five wide leaving the far turn then finished evenly through the stretch run. SARAVA bobbed slightly at the break but was never far back racing three wide but had no late impact. ROGUE AGENT raced up close four wide early, was three wide into the final turn while in striking position but soon tired. BASIL'S RHYTHM was off slow, saved all ground but was never involved. ON THE GAME raced in contention three-four wide early, made a bid four wide into the far turn then soon tired.
