WOLF MOON vied inside early, drew off final turn, steady urging to wire. DIXIE CAUSEWAY three wide along first turn, two wide run far bend, good second. ALA AL DIN chased two wide early, outside on final turn, tired. REAL GENTLEMAN outrun saving ground, never reached contention, no speed. EDDIE'S POINT off step slow, chased outside, never involved. CHASING THE STORM angled outside entering first turn, no response, tired. DREAM HOLIDAY prompted pace two wide of winner, gave way into lane, empty.
