ENDLESS PLEASURE was hustled two wide to command, set the pace uncontested, repulsed bids on the far turn and nearing the finish and just lasted. MIESQUE'S ABROJO stalked inside, steadied a bit into the backstretch, made a strong bid inside the winner, lost that position and altered course outside that rival then continued game to finished in a dead-heat for the place. ROSHNETI was never to far back, raced four wide leaving the far turn, closed strongly from the outside and hung late. STRONGWILLED STUKA settled on the rail, was three wide into the final turn but lacked a late punch. GREEN GINGHAM GIRL prompted the pace two wide, faded three wide into the lane and went evenly thereafter. HOT JELLY JAM, wide early, loomed four wide into the stretch then flattened out. LITTLE COMPTON chased saving ground while never far back but had no final response. PRINCESS TERLINGUA reared slightly then wheeled to the outside leaving the gate and nearly unseated the rider then was outrun. MISS I. Q. off slow, three path early, outrun.
