DIXIELANDBANDITO attended pace two wide, narrow advantage far turn, faded. WHOOPI AGAIN forced pace two wide, clear into final turn, tired. BRIDLE WAY BAY up close inside, loomed two wide final turn, tired. ROYAL CITIZEN three wide chasing leaders, no response into lane, tired. LAMSTER hustled inside, disputed pace to far turn, empty. MAJOR GOLD outrun throughout, no speed, no apparent mishap.
