MILKY MAY settled three wide, four into lane, outside run, drew off, drive. GIMMEONEMORE well placed two wide, three wide into lane, game for place. GORDIAN KNOT chased saving ground turn, no serious response, evenly. NUMEROUS ONE unhurried to turn, angled outside into stretch, belated interest. SURF ROAD battled two wide along turn, narrowly in front mid-stretch, faded. WESTERN SUNSHINE hustled inside to command, yielded inside furlong marker, tired. DIAMOND COUNTY blocked, steadied into turn, gave way, eased upper stretch. IMPRESSIVE STORM broke in tangle, rider lost irons, far back, pulled up.
