CARAMELEN dueled outside into the stretch and drew off under steady urging. THEPRESIDENTALLION stalked the pace three-wide, bid into the stretch, proved no match for the winner but was second best. BELMONT ROAD was slow early, ducked left toward the first turn, straightened, taken up in tight quarters and hit the rail, rallied on the turn, angled in altered course to the rail in the upper stretch while moving well but was soon done. BROADWAY HAT dueled to the stretch and gave way. PATRIOT CLASS stumbled at the start and ducked out, trailed and passed tiring rivals. SON OF LILLY was done early. DRUNKEN SPIDER had only brief speed. TINTO was slow early and trailed.
