THE FLATS never far back inside, two wide move off far bend, stiff drive. CHARM THE CROWD bumped at break, three wide run far turn, late bid inside winner. BUDDHA'S STAR three wide into first turn, rail into far turn, three wide bid. EASY POLLY saved ground throughout, rail bid into lane, weakened. EL ESTRELLITA took control two wide, well clear along far turn, tired. SUNSET AFFAIR on hedge first turn, angled out far turn, no impact. SECRET HONOR in contention two wide, no response into stretch, weakened. SOUTHERN ADVICE broke inward bit, steadied, never involved, saved ground. COLOR BOOK disputed pace inside, bore out some midway far turn, tired. WEDDING BELLS SOON two wide early, pulled up, apparent saddle slip first turn. The rider of CHARM THE CROWD alleged interference in deep stretch against the rider of the winner, but was denied by the stewards.
