Footnotes

NATIONAL HERO was never too far back racing two wide, moved out with a four wide move off the turn then made a late surge from the outside and just got up. SWAMPY TOWN vied for command inside, edged clear entering upper lane then yielded grudgingly when leading late. E. J. LITTLE BOY steadied a bit into the turn, made a bid inside into upper stretch and continued gamely. COPELAN'S RIDGE narrow advantage two wide, yielded to rival mid-stretch, weakened. LIR JET up close three wide into turn, couldn't keep pace into lane, fade. CROWN COLONY (GB) chased two wide along turn, no serious menace, evenly. ENVOY'S SECRET in contention from inside, no menacing response, weakened. SAND SLIDER saved ground along turn, never reached contention, no bid. ZIPPER chased outside along turn, no response into lane, no impact. BIG CASH bumped bit at break, outrun two-three paths, no response.
