COPELAN'S RIDGE bumped start, three-four wide run turn, strong finish, up. SWAMPY TOWN forced pace two wide, led into stretch, willingly. ZIPPER never too far back inside, steady advance turn, closed well. GLOWING PROMISE in close contention three wide, loomed, outfinished late. FORTUNATE TRAIL chased two wide turn, inside off turn, belated response. BEDFORD ARCH moved inside entering turn, no menacing bid into lane, faded. I'M IT WAYNE hustled inside rivals, pace on rail turn, weakened. BARRY STORM chased two wide along turn, never menaced leaders, no mishap. SAND SLIDER never too far back early, no response turn, weakened. DYER MAKER chased saving ground, no menacing bid, no mishap.
