**Footnotes**

BLUESMAN stalked from just off the rail, went after the leader entering upper stretch then drove clear inside final furlong. HARVICK was sent to command, set the pace on or near the rail but couldn't match strides late. SEPTEMBER HERO off step slow and unhurried, went four wide into the far turn then finished best of the rest. CARSON UNLEASHED was three wide chasing, raced contention to the stretch then weakened. PATRIOTS PEAK saved ground throughout, was never too far back, faded stretch. HELLCAT PILOT speed two wide, steadily lost contact, tired. MONTMORENCI off step slow, two wide early, empty stretch run.
