Footnotes

B B'S CONCORDE stalked the pace four wide through the opening half-mile, advanced in the three path rounding the far turn, steadily gained through the lane and wore down his foe late. BIG MAHOGANY pressed the pace three wide around the first turn, dueled outside down the backstretch, drew clear around the far turn, held clear past the eighth pole, continued on his left lead in the lane and weakened between foes late. OSTIN'S MIRACLE was unhurried while racing six wide around the first turn, continued five five wide around the far turn and rallied belatedly to gain the show in the final strides. RICHIE RULES saved ground, rallied inside in upper stretch, bid near the sixteenth pole, then checked when it looked like it might get tight in deep stretch. VAN LEROY set the pace along the rail and tired around the far turn. ROCK COLONY failed to menace while racing four wide. PAP'S PAL never factored while racing five wide.
