NATIONAL HERO stalked the duel three wide, rallied outside, took command in deep stretch and won going away. NOBLE TIGER settled just off the duel along the inside, bid inside of the pacesetter in midstretch, took the lead leaving the eighth pole but could not resist the winner in the late yards. SWAMPY TOWN dueled inside of E. J. LITTLE BOY to upper stretch, edged ahead of that foe but weakened in the final furlong. E. J. LITTLE BOY dueled two wide and gave way in upper stretch. CODIGO POSTAL failed to menace while racing three wide. COCKEYED ROOSTER was outrun while racing off the rail. MO DULAR trailed.
