Footnotes

FLEET DYNA was never far back, stalked along the rail, gained command in mid-stretch, responded to steady right-handed urging and drew clear late. MORE IS BETTER stalked the pace while racing outside a foe, assumed command into the lane, could not match strides with FLEET DYNA in the late going but finished willingly for the place. SILENT WISPER raced along the inside early while saving ground, advanced between horses and showed good late effort. SMOOTH CONNECTION set the pace along the inside and tired on the second turn. MINI GOAL raced four wide throughout and showed no late bid. GRAND MADAM raced four wide on the first turn and showed no rally. EIGHTYFIVE S pressed the pace, led briefly into the stretch and tired. CONSOLACION SUR raced four wide into the first turn, was void of early foot and never rallied. QUIET WAVE was slow early, raced four wide into the stretch and was outrun. SNEAKY GIRL raced in the second flight, dropped back and was outrun.
