**Footnotes**

LIGHTNING POWER rated back shortly after the start, was content to trail the field, angled out for room into the stretch and finished fast to draw clear late. LONELY WHISTLE was unhurried early, raced four wide into the lane and showed a good late effort. FLYING STONE pressed the pace along the rail and finished willingly. OLDE KINGS HIGHWAY was unhurried early along the inside and improved his position from between foes. LAST LAUGH NOW was never far back while racing outside a rival and lacked a late response. EXCHANGE THE LIMIT was away alertly to set the pace while saving ground and tired in the final furlong. PUT TO THE TEST lunged at the start while having his jockey lose the irons, raced in contention for a half mile, was eased into the second turn and to the wire. THE STEWARDS POSTED THE INQUIRY SIGN INTO THE START OF THE RACE BUT MADE NO CHANGE.
