NEVA MASQUERADE was away alertly, opened up a clear lead shortly after the start, increased his advantage to the wire and was in hand late. GREAT RECESSION was allowed to settle outside a rival, swung five wide for the drive and showed a good late effort. FANEUIL WILDCAT was content to be the early trailer, angled out into the stretch and showed his best stride late from mid-track. DONNA'S GLITTER was never far back along the inside and lacked a late response. CODE TAKER was unhurried early, raced four wide into the stretch and improved his position. HI TIDE BOY broke sharply, pressed the pace off the rail and tired in the final furlong. ALPHA BEAR stalked the early pace from along the inside and faltered.
