BEIJING HOUSE was unhurried early, rallied three-wide on the second turn, angled out four-wide moving well into the final furlong and was up in the final 80 yards. SINGING MY WAY pressed the pace, bid for the lead in the upper stretch, held a short lead in the middle of the stretch and weakened. TOMORROWS WILDCAT quickly took command, led into the final furlong and weakened. CLASSIC SPEED was beaten to a hole early, swung five-wide rushing to press the pace, loomed boldly into the stretch but tired near the final furlong. NEWTON CRESCENT raced in the middle of the pack and had a mild rally. BALLADO ALERT hit the gate and was outrun. COMMERSANT pressed the pace into the turn and weakened. MANGROVE POND pressed the pace to the turn and gave way. ACT ONE SCENE ONE had only brief speed.
