KHAN OF KHANS broke well to press the pace on the outside, dueled with WAR FOR GUS into the stretch, drew off and was kept to strong urging. LIBERTY ST. OUTLAW was slow early, rallied into the stretch, angled out to far outside and finished strongly. WAR FOR GUS quickly took command, dueled inside the winner to the stretch, weakened a bit there and then finished well. GRAND CAPTAIN raced in the middle of the pack to the turn, bore out badly and finished well. ASHQUAR dropped back after the start, rallied into the turn, angled in behind GRAND CAPTAIN but was soon through. GET BACK JACK has only brief speed. TURBEYVILLE had brief speed and bore out on the turn. HALLS OF IVY had no speed. FLYING SON was outrun. PAYOFF PITCH trailed.
