OPEN YOUR EYES dueled two wide early, drew off into upper stretch while under urging then just lasted after having her rider ease up forty yards from the finish. SPANISH LADY was unhurried saving ground, rallied along the rail around the final turn then closed willingly and just missed. CINNAMON SECRET was off slow and on the rail early, went two wide into the stretch but had no late impact. ASSETS OF GOLD was a bit fractious in the gate then bumped slightly by her outside rival just after the break, raced three wide into the lane but was not a factor. MIESQUE'S DAUGHTER brief early lead, dueled on rail to backstretch, tired. DOVEENA forced out into first turn, three wide far turn, tired. TWIST AND SHOOT fractious in gate, chased inside rivals, tired. LADY IRENE was very fractious in the gate, raced three wide into the first turn and tired. BLUE MAGNOLIA bore out into the first turn and was never involved thereafter. E Z SMILE brief speed four wide early, readily gave way leaving backstretch and was eased up through the final furlong while crossing the finish.
