STEP BROTHER dueled three-wide on both turns, gained a short lead at the quarter pole, responded gamely to AMBARONA's challenge from the upper stretch to the final sixteenth and then was all out to hold sway. LT. KOJAK raced in the middle of the pack, rallied inside into the stretch and finished well. AMBARONA was forced seven-wide into the first turn and trailed, rallied five-wide into the stretch to loom boldly in the upper stretch and weakened a sixteenth out. CLEVER COYOTE dueled to the stretch and tired. C F'S BULLET was slow early, rushed between horses approaching the first turn, bore out five-wide on the first turn, raced in the middle of the pack to the second turn and bore out again. ADVANCEANDRETREAT dueled between horses to the stretch and tired. BRIAN'S SPITFIRE was fractious in the gate, broke in the air, rushed between horses approaching the first turn, was forced six-wide on the turn and trailed.
