NEVA MASQUERADE pressed the pace to the turn, drew off quickly, held a long lead a furlong out and was gently ridden. LIBERTY ST. OUTLAW was outrun early, split rivals rallying into the stretch and finished well. FRANKIE RULES saved ground in the middle of the pack and had a mild rally. SINGINGMYHYMNSONG was outrun, advanced four-wide on the turn and fanned five-wide into the stretch. COCKEYED ROOSTER pressed the pace and weakened on the turn. DEERSLAYER was well placed, stalked three-wide into the stretch and weakened. FEDERAL HILL raced widest in the middle of the pack and fanned six-wide. HAIL CONCORDE hesitated at the start and trailed to the final furlong. APPEALING YANKEE quickly took command, was no match for the winner, remained prominent to the final furlong and then was used up.
