JACOB'S DREAM pressed the pace, gained command a furlong out and was ridden out. DOUBLE DANCER set a pressured pace to the final furlong, couldn't match strides with the winner but was clearly second best. STAND UP STAN raced early in the middle of the pack, rallied into the stretch but couldn't threaten the top pair. TRULY SMART was unhurried early and was no threaten with a late gain. LT. KOJAK was outrun. TELL GRANT had brief speed and tired. ELECTRO BEAT pressed the pace to the second turn and tired. HURRICANE LIGHT raced in the middle of the pack, in tight quarters behind rivals and was then outrun. ETHAN JOHN was outrun while wide. CASTIEL trailed.
