JOKESONME settled inside early, eased out leaving the far turn to be four abreast in upper stretch then was fully extended to last. PLINKING stalked from the rail, tried to slip through along the inside entering the stretch, checked in tight in upper stretch, altered course to the outside of rivals and closed gamely while likely best. GOLD NOT DIAMONDS was never far back, three wide early, rail into the lane and was closing well late. STAR OF COLLEEN L. chased saving ground, three wide into stretch, weakened. MIESQUE'S ABROJO forwardly placed two wide, couldn't keep pace far turn, evenly. SINN FREE hustled clear, set pace into stretch, weakened. STRONGWILLED STUKA drifted off rail early, chased outside off far turn, needed more. FAST DELIGHTER settled inside, saved ground throughout, tired. CLARIDGES outrun three wide early, never involved. GUESTBOOK chased two wide, gave way early, tired.
