Footnotes

PETUNIA BE CAREFUL rated, rallied between mares on the turn and drew off on the inside near the final sixteenth. PHRYGIAN raced five-wide in the middle of the pack, rallied into the stretch and finished well. DOUBLE REALITY dueled to the turn, bore out into the turn, held a clear lead three-wide into the final furlong and gave way. SWEET JALEENA stalked the pace and had no rally. ESTHER IRON CROSS dueled three-wide to the turn, went wider and tired. DAKOTA SUN dueled between mares to the turn, went wide and tired. BELL DRIVE was outrun. BAY ROOT showed nothing. APPEALING LILLY was no menace. SPECTRAL hit the gate and trailed, rushed behind horses and was blocked near the half-mile pole, angled in to the rail while moving well into the turn but was soon done.
