LEON ROYALE went clear into turn, drew off leaving the turn, drifted sharply throughout the stretch run and was all out regaining the lead in the final strides. MR. JOLSON raced close up inside, angled out off the turn, battled with the winner side-by-side and carried extremely far out into the lane and yielded grudgingly. BEAM ME UP never far back, rallied inside leaving the turn, led late then hung in the final strides. RAMPANT was slow into stride, went two wide with his move off the turn, closing willingly. KING MONGO chased from just off the inside, had no serious response and finished evenly. CONQUER'S ANJIZ chased near or on the inside, had no menacing response, need more. PEWTER up close three wide into turn, no response turn, tired. PUNCH THE ODDS attended pace two wide into turn, gave way into lane, tired. Following an Inquiry by the Stewards and an objection by the rider of MR. JOLSON against the rider of LEON ROYALE for alleged interference in the stretch run, the latter was disqualified and placed SECOND.
