GAMBLER'S HONOUR dueled for a half, quickly drew off and was powered down in the final sixteenth. QUAD'S DOUBLE stalked the pace early while angling to the rail, couldn't catch the winner but finished well. HELLO D. NGATA was outrun early, was blocked behind rivals from the half-mile pole to the stretch, split rivals, angled out and finished well. BEACHMONT BOUND raced four-wide in the middle of the pack and had no rally. COCO TOP raced in the middle of the pack and had no rally. MR. B. W. dueled for the lead on the outside to the stretch and gave way. NO MORE GOODBYES stalked the early pace three-wide, bid for the lead near the quarter pole and then tired in the final furlong. LOOK TO THE FUTURE raced in the middle of the pack to the turn and gave way. MALKEINU trailed.
