Footnotes

ROBBIE'S EXPRESS settled inside, three wide move off far turn, drove clear. H M S ANNIVERSARY saved ground to far turn, two wide off far bend, willingly. CARRY THE DAY two wide early, rail move to command far turn, grudgingly. MUNITION moved inside on first turn, two wide into stretch, late run. MANZANA off step slow, settled two wide, three wide final turn, evenly. EL PADRON disputed pace two wide early, yielded into upper stretch, faded. CROWN COLONY (GB) close up three wide, no response along far turn, tired. SARATOGA BLITZ contested pace along inside, gave way into lane, tired. STORM FORECASTER three wide into first turn, no response along inside far turn. MASTER GINO in close contention three wide early, empty final turn, tired. The race was delayed almost one hour after rider was injured on EL PADRON and officials waited until another ambulance was on the grounds.
