GLOWING PROMISE pressed the early pace, moved quickly to gain a clear lead near the quarter pole and was kept to intermittent urging. QUAD'S DOUBLE pressed the pace on the inside, steadied repeatedly in tight quarters to near the turn, angled out and rallied to loom boldly a furlong out and hung. COCO TOP raced evenly. BIG CASH dueled briefly, took a short lead near the half pole and tired into the stretch. FREE CANDY was passed tiring rivals. NO MORE GOODBYES raced wide and tired. ROCK COLONY was outrun. PROWL ON trailed.
