CLASSIC ACRE was quickly sent to command, raced on or near the inside setting all the pace, drew well clear inside the furlong marker then was kept to steady urging while never seriously threatened. CAT TOPPER, slow early, eased out leaving the turn then closed willingly outside rivals through the stretch run. ANGEL BY DAY, in contention three wide, was four wide into the stretch then continued evenly late. MAGAZINE LANE was up close inside, chased the winner into the lane, weakened. RIOT ALERT was never far back early, saved ground throughout, weakened. RED RONNIE four wide into turn, five wide into the stretch then had no late response. DR RICO forwardly placed two wide, faded leaving turn, tired. BANKIN CASH in contention two wide, three wide into lane, tired.
