VICAR IN THE HOUSE sent quickly clear, repulsed a strong bid off the far turn then kept to strong urging to finish. HI POPPY in contention inside, rallied between rivals in deep stretch and continued game. OJIBWAY two wide early, three wide into stretch, good finish but needed more final seventy yards. OUTSHINE raced four wide early, made a four wide bid into the final turn, weakened. ROME IS BURNING settled outside early, three wide far turn, improved position. JOMA in contention three wide, couldn't keep pace far turn, tired. WHOOP! AGAIN chased two wide throughout, couldn't keep pace, tired. EAGLE BEAGLE four wide into first turn, along rail into stretch, tired. BABALALO settled two wide, five wide into stretch, tired. OLD IRONSIDES bid three wide into far turn, gave way into lane, tired. THEATRICAL TALENT moved outside off first turn, no response far turn, tired.
