Footnotes

CINDYRELLA saved ground to the second turn, split rivals rallying on the turn, angled inside into the stretch to gain command near the final furlong and drew off under steady urging. CONSOLACION SUR bore out on the first turn, rallied four-wide on the second turn, fanned six-wide in the upper stretch and finished well. OLIVIA TWIST went three-wide into the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside on the backstretch, rallied four-wide into the second turn, bid for the lead near the quarter pole and weakened nearing the final furlong. IDON'TKNOGOASKANNI broke well to duel between mares into the first turn, dueled outside to the second turn, dueled on the inside near the quarter pole and tired in the upper stretch. MARCIANNIE was outrun and bore out into the second turn. SAY TOBA SANDY stalked the pace, bid three-wide into the second turn and gave way. TRIPPINDOWNDAHIWAY dueled for five furlongs and was used up.
