Footnotes

BEST CHUM unhurried early, bided time along inside, surged clear on rail. TOTALLY DEDICATED close up four wide into turn, loomed into lane, held place. SUNDANCE RICHIE never too far back, closed outside upper stretch, late share. RADICAL STORM hustled to command, set pace along rail turn, drifted approaching the furlong marker then faded. DENNISPORT well placed inside to stretch, checked while angling out a bit in mid-stretch then lost all chance and faded. HANDSOME REWARD up close two wide along turn, yielded between rivals turn, faded. EPISODE ON TOUR forwardly placed three wide, steadied bit upper stretch, weakened. The Stewards disqualified RADICAL STORM from fourth to fifth for causing interference in mid-stretch and after an objection by the rider of DENNISPORT for alleging interference against RADICAL STORM.
