LENDING FREEZE well placed two wide into turn, rallied inside rivals into upper stretch, surged to the front passing the furlong marker then drew clear under strong handling. WHO'S WILLIE FITZ stalked pace just off inside, three wide upper stretch, gamely. FIREPOLE took command inside, drifted a bit into the lane then weakened. SLEW OF SMOKE off slow, saved ground along turn, passed tiring rivals. ONE BIG CAT in contention three wide into turn, faded into lane, tired. GIANT chased two wide into turn, no menacing response, tired. AHOY MAE TEE chased three wide into turn, no response into lane, tired. PAPS PAL well placed inside to turn, gave way into lane, tired.
