Footnotes

JOLIE GOOD settled inside and was reserved for a half, split rivals two wide leaving the turn and through the stretch run then drove clear late. AMAZING THUNDER was never far back throughout, was boxed in entering the final turn, eased out in upper stretch then continued game for the place. ENDLESS PLEASURE stalked from the inside, made a three wide bid leaving the far turn, battled heads apart in midstretch then gradually faded late. OUR REVIVAL, well placed three wide early, was blocked briefly leaving the far turn and weakened. JEWEL ALARM was four wide into the backstretch, forced the pace to the far turn and weakened along the rail. STRODEE assumed command, repulsed a bid midway along the backstretch, edged clear again then weakened through the final furlong. PLEASANTON stumbled just after the start and was outrun from the three-four path.
