SUGAR TRADE vied inside rivals on the rail, edged clear off the turn then was kept to steady urging. MISS ACCOMAC in contention behind leaders, angled outside off the turn then continued gamely for second. SHE'S GOLDEN chased two wide into turn, eased out into stretch, bested rest. FAITHFUL ONE off step slow, chased near or on inside turn, evenly late. BEAUTIFUL INSIGHT jostled bit break, chased three wide into turn, weakened. ALY PIE forced pace two wide, between rivals into turn, tired. COCKTAIL MUSIC forced pace four wide, outside rivals into turn, tired. COPELAN COUNTY forced pace three wide, between rivals into turn, eased late.
