FEODOR was well placed saving ground to the stretch, rallied to gain command a sixteenth out and quickly drew out. COMMERSANT pressed the pace into the second turn, angled outside to challenge COOL YOURPIPES nearing the stretch and finished well. COOLYOURPIPES quickly took command, held a clear lead to midstretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. STORM CLOUDS AHEAD raced wide in the middle of the pack, rallied four-wide on the second turn, loomed boldly entering the stretch but lacked a late response. BECAUSE I WIN raced in the middle of pack and ran evenly. MY BAMBINO was outrun to the stretch and passed tiring rivals. SILKS SOLOTUDE was slow early and no threat with a mild advance. SHARP DADDY pressed the pace into the second turn and tired. AVARAS was outrun. TRILLIONAIRE broke well to race in the middle of the pack on the first turn but was done entering the backstretch.
