COCKEYED ROOSTER quickly took command, dueled on the turn, drew off near the final sixteenth and was kept to steady urging. DEERSLAYER pressed the pace to the turn, dueled on the outside into the final furlong and weakened. ROODE DUDE stalked the leaders three-wide into the stretch and weakened. LIBERTY ST. OUTLAW was well placed and had no rally. FRANKIE RULES raced in the middle of the pack and had no rally. DEBLUE was outrun while wide. ADARO was outrun. PRINCE TOGIK was no threat. FEDERAL HILL had speed to the turn, tired and trailed.
