SEPTEMBER HERO three wide early, rallied inside far turn, drove to front late. OUR SUN prompted pace two wide, edged clear into lane, game effort. CODIGO POSTAL settled inside, four wide run off final turn, willingly stretch. BEDFORD ARCH up close two wide, loomed on rail into final turn, evenly. CLASS DISMISSED steadied along inside early, bid two wide off far turn, faded. GOLD PAGEANTRY off step slow, three wide into first turn, no menacing response. MR GUSKA off step slow, three wide attending early pace, weakened. DENNISPORT along hedge contesting early pace, gave way far turn, tired. STEEL TRAIN far back early, no apparent mishap, running over wire. NANA'S HOPE chased inside, eased through stretch run over wire.
