THE MOUNT was always clear and along the rail throughout then widened into the stretch and was under a vigorous hand ride stretch. O'MALLEY raced inside early, was fanned four wide into the stretch then closed game for the place. SEPTEMBER HERO angled inside early, saved ground off the final turn and continued with an even finish. RUSSIAN WILD LIFE three wide early, outrun on rail far turn, no menacing response. PROSPECTORS LEGACY up close two wide early, couldn't match strides, weakened. GLOBE FISH three wide early, drifted out leaving final turn, tired.
