BREW FOR THE BAND assumed control early, repulsed bid far turn, just held late. A BEE C unhurried early, angled out into upper stretch, fast finish. BEAU BOCK in close contention three wide, fell back far turn, late re-bid. BAY MINER in contention two wide, saved ground final turn, evenly late. BRIDLE WAY BAY prompted pace from inside, battled into lane, weakened. EMANATE four wide into first turn, loomed final turn, weakened. COOL TALES chased outside throughout, no late punch, weakened. AFRICAN ANGEL in contention three wide, two wide final turn, weakened.
