SUMMER OF SUMMERS dueled for the lead to the second turn, drew off and prevailed under strong urging. BUCKS WINK was bumped at the start and angled inside while trailing, split rivals rallying into the stretch and finished very well. PREACHER BUCK dueled for the lead outside the winner, stalked to the final sixteenth and weakened. TO THE MOON was well placed and lacked a rally. O'KID was outrun. SGT. EMBLETON was bumped at the start, was well placed early and tired. ACTIVE TRADER caused bumping at the start, dueled three-wide on the first turn and then gave way.
