LEVY LIGHT was outrun to the second turn, advanced five-wide into the stretch and was resolute to be up in the final 40 yards. SOUTHERN TAP broke well to duel to the first turn, angled in sharply causing CARCAVA'S HUNT to take up, dueled inside that rival from the middle of the first turn to the three-eighths pole, drew off to a long lead and weakened in the final sixteenth. PRECEDENT was bumped at the start, raced three-wide while outrun for a half, saved ground rallying into the stretch and had a mild response in the upper stretch. SWEET LIL CHEROKEE was rank, hit the gate, bumped into PRECEDENT after the start, then pinballed WEDDING BELLS SOON and POCAHONTAS' LEGEND before the first turn, stalked the leaders to the stretch and gave way. WEDDING BELLS SOON was bumped early and went wide on the first turn, was outrun while racing in the middle of the pack, had mild response four-wide on the second turn and tired. CARCAVA'S HUNT broke well to duel to the first turn, was put in tight quarters along the rail, took up and angled out, dueled on the outside to the three-eighths pole and gave way. POCAHONTAS' LEGEND broke well to run in the middle of the pack for three-sixteenths, was bumped, lost her action and was eased from the five-eighths pole to the finish. AN OBEJECTION BY THE RIDER OF CARCAVA'S HUNT AGAINST THE RIDER OF SOUTHERN TAP, ALLEGING INTERENCE ENTERING THE FIRST TURN, WAS NOT ALLOWED.
