B L'S WAGON dueled into the backstretch, drew off on the second turn, held a long lead into the stretch and was kept to mild urging. WITT'S FOXY raced three-wide on the first turn, advanced three-wide into the second turn, angled in near the quarter pole and finished well. WALKINGTONBROADWAY pressed the pace four-wide on the first turn, stalked the pace three-wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. COP COOKIE was outrun and fanned five-wide in the stretch. DOUBLE SHADOW trailed for a half and passed tiring rivals. MAKEITORBREAKIT was well placed on the outside to the second turn and fanned four-wide tiring in the stretch. TOMO NIGHTS dueled early, stalked the winner for five furlongs and gave way. J. W.'S CRYSTAL was never a factor. VOODOO DARLIN was through early.
