GRAND MADAM settled outside entering the turn, made a four wide move off the turn then surged clear outside final sixteenth. STORM GAL up close inside, made a two wide move off the turn, bumped with inside rival off turn, angled out mid-stretch and closed willingly. INSTANT LADY in close contention three wide, battled through the lane then yielded late. UNO ROYALE off step slow, angled out three wide off turn, closed gamely late. LITTLE TARA hustled clear to gain inside, battled into deep stretch, weakened. GIVONNA ALYSSA forced pace between rivals early, two wide along turn, faded. MISS GOLD INDY up close inside, was steadied along the turn then checked in tight and bumped with a rival and gradually weakened after. An objection by the rider of MISS GOLD INDY against the rider of STORM GAL was dismissed.
