LIGHTNING POWER was slow early, steadily advanced to the second turn, rallied five-wide into the stretch and finished well to be along in time. COWGIRLS FIRST pressed the early pace, dueled on the outside on the backstretch, gained a clear lead on the second turn, dueled with the winner nearing the final furlong and weakened a bit late. LATER GATER trailed to the second turn, rallied into the stretch and finished well. OLDE KINGS HIGHWAY was well placed in the middle of the pack between rivals into the second turn, rallied four-wide into the stretch and finished well. SOCIALIST stalked the early lead, moved up closer to the leader on the second turn and weakened in the final furlong. LONELY WHISTLE was well placed between rivals to the stretch and tired. BORACAY WONDER set the pace for a half, remained prominent to the stretch and tired. FLYING STONE raced four-wide in the middle of the pack to the second turn and gave way.
