**Footnotes**

MISS TRICKY ME sprinted clear, dropped back when challenged on the backstretch, came again to gain command near the final sixteenth and drew off. FORMAL PRINCESS had a rough trip, broke well but steadied before the first turn, angled out before being forced four-wide at the middle of the first turn, raced between rivals, bumped hard with MO DIDN'T KNOW after a half and was blocked, fanned four-wide on the second turn and finished with unusual courage. MO DIDN'T KNOW went five-wide on the first turn, raced wide in the middle of the pack on the backstretch, bumped foe, rallied on the second turn but lacked the needed late response. MARVELOCITY was bumped at the start and saved ground to no avail. PICK THE DOUBLE ducked out at the start bumping PRINCESS APPEAL, pinballed into MARVELOCITY, rushed to press the pace for three furlongs, drew off before the half-mile pole, had a clear lead a furlong out and weakened. MONJABLANCA was squeezed at the start, raced in the middle of the pack and had no rally. ARBELLE ducked out into AVANDA'S DESTINY at the start, went four-wide on the first turn, trailed and passed tiring rivals. AVANDA'S DESTINY was pinched back at the start, went six-wide on the first turn and was no threat. BOP BOP A DO WOP went four-wide on the first turn, had speed to the second turn but done at the three-eighths pole. PRINCESS APPEAL was bumped at the start, went three-wide on the first turn and was through early.
