SVETLANA broke alert to quickly take command in the two-path, steadily increased her lead and won with speed to spare. GRACE STONE MANOR broke well to press the pace to the first turn, came in causing bumping between the other rivals, was forced wide and raced in closest attendance. MAKEITORBREAKIT was quickly taken up from the crowding into the first turn and went six-wide and had no rally. TORI N JOEY'S ROSE broke well and then was bumped hard into the first turn, took up and was outrun. COP COOKIE was steadied on the first turn and outrun. J'S DREAM was bumped and forced wider into the first turn, was well placed early and tired. J. W.'S CRYSTAL broke well to duel into the first turn, caused leftward crowding, trailed to second turn and was outrun. MISS KAISER broke slowly, rushed into danger between rivals into the first turn and caused crowding, hit the rail just before the backstretch, tired and was eased. The stewards reviewed the actions on the first turn and allowed the result to stand.
