POCKET COWBOYS broke well and then was hard to handle before a bad step entering the first turn, settled in stride into the backstretch, dueled to the three-eighths pole, drew off and was kept to strong urging. FLEETWING ducked in to bump BELIEVE IN WEST at the start, was outrun to the second turn and passed tiring rivals. GET READY GO was outrun to the second turn and passed tiring rivals. LIGHTNING N HAIL was slow early, rushed five-wide into the first turn, was forced seven-wide into the backstretch, dueled to the three-eighths pole and tired. BELIEVE IN WEST went four-wide on the first turn, had a mild rally on the second turn and tired. VICAR IN THE HOUSE went three-wide into the first turn and showed nothing. LEGENDARY KING broke well to duel into the first turn, bore out midway of the turn, forcing LIGHTNING N HAIL wider and was done after three furlongs.
