SIREN'S STEP pressed the pace three-wide into the turn, dueled on the turn, battled through the stretch and prevailed under strong urging. ORIENTAL QUEEN pressed the pace, split rivals into the final furlong, drew even in the middle of the stretch and gave a good effort. VALLEY NEWS pressed the pace to the turn, dueled between mares to the stretch, held a short lead near the final furlong and weakened in the middle of the stretch. PRECEDENT was outrun to the stretch while saving ground and finished well. SUPER CRAFT trailed early, came widest into the stretch and finished well. GRAND MADAM was well placed, went six-wide in the middle of the pack and tired. PUT IT AWAY sprinted clear, dueled inside on the turn, battled into the final furlong and gave way. BRESSIE had brief speed.
