SARAH JADE saved ground, chased pacesetter, weakened deep stretch. DANIA BAY advanced outside, moved closer far turn, flattened out. IMMORTAL CHARM chased outside, failed to threaten. BUT MOMMY chased off rail, failed to threaten. MEGAN'S HALO moved up inside, never a threat. ISLAND MELODY was never a factor. SILVERTON BAY up close and outside, tired. WORLDLY PLEASURE saved ground, tired.
